Candidates must have experience in the form of **EITHER** involvement on a project registered for LEED certification **OR** current or previous employment in a sustainable field of work **OR** *enrollment in or completion of an education program that addresses green building principles.* **Only one of these criteria must be met to demonstrate eligibility.**

* Students who pass the LEED-GA exam after the workshop series will have the cost of the exam covered by LAVC. This is a \$150 savings in addition to the free workshop series.
